## PERSON TO PERSON TRANSFERS VIA BILLPAY

There is a wonderful feature we want to make our members aware of. You can do person to person transfers through our bill pay website. You can access our bill pay website through our internet banking website. Once in the bill pay website, click on "Pay a person". There are three options to choose from but we found the "Email or text message" option is the easiest to do. All you do is enter the name and phone number of the person you want to send money to. You then create a keyword that both you and the person receiving the money will need to know. Once you finish setting everything up, you will enter the amount you want to send. When that is done, the person receiving the money will get a text message and a link to enter the keyword and their account information. Both the sender and receiver will be kept updated on the status of the transfer. The initial transfer may take 3 to

5 days. Any additional transfers you do with this person will take 1 to 2 days. This is a safe and easy option to transfer money to someone. We hope you like it as well!

## DEPOSIT HOLDS WITH YOUR DEBIT CARD

Many members are now using various cash apps to send and receive funds. Many members also link there debit card to these cash apps. This is something we do not recommend. When you link your debit card to the cash apps and you receive a deposit, the debit card provider automatically puts a 3 day hold on a portion of the funds. It will be 3 business days before you will have access to all of those funds. It is better to link your cash apps to your account directly by providing your account number and routing number. There will never be a hold on funds if it is sent this way. So please keep this in mind the next time you use your cash apps.

## TEXTING SERVICE NOW AVAILABLE

Over 6 billion text messages are sent in the United States every day. It is the most popular way to communicate in our world today. That is why Teachers Credit Union now has a new text messaging service for our members. It will allow our members to digitally communicate in a secure and compliant way. The texting service will also allow the credit union to keep members informed while providing convenience for you. The texting service will allow us to collect documents from members with a secure link sent by text. The service also uses

a text based two factor authentication for added security. To sign up for this service, visit our website at www.tcubeloit.org and click on the Text Messaging link. There you can scan the QR code or enter your name and phone number to opt-in to the Text Messaging Service. There are two numbers you will receive text messages from. ## TCU HONORED WITH MCKINNEY VENTO AWARD FOR HELPING HOMELESS STUDENTS



Several local businesses and organizations joined together in November to purchase gift cards for homeless and unaccompanied students and their families in November. The McKinney Vento Program, which works to remove barriers for homeless students in the School District of Beloit, coordinated the "Throw Down: Race to Generosity" campaign from Nov. 2 — 30, which challenged local businesses and agencies to see who could collect the most gift cards for homeless families. November is National Hunger and Homeless Awareness Month. The Greater Beloit Chamber of Commerce and the Beloit Economic Development Corp. partnered with the McKinney Vento Program to see who could collect the most gas cards, grocery cards, fast food cards and gift cards for

Teachers Credit Union (1 to 50 employees) Angus Young Associates (50 to 100 employees) City of Beloit (over 100 employees) Fifteen businesses and organizations participated in the "Throw Down" campaign.

Robin Stuht, family specialist with the McKinney Vento Program, said 476 students in the School District of Beloit have been identified as homeless/unaccompanied.

"That is the largest amount we have ever had at this time of year, but we know we haven't identified all of them," she said.
